

Assessed Control of Terrain in Ukraine and Main Russian Maneuver Axes as of August 22, 2022, 3:00 PM ET




Assessed Control of Terrain Around Donetsk as of August 22, 2022, 3:00 PM ET




Assessed Control of Terrain Around Donetsk as of August 21, 2022, 3:00 PM ET




Assessed Control of Terrain Around Donetsk as of August 18, 2022, 3:00 PM ET




Assessed Control of Terrain Around Kharkiv as of August 21, 2022, 3:00 PM ET






Assessed Control of Terrain Around Kherson and Mykolaiv as of August 21, 2022, 3:00 PM ET


Assessed Control of Terrain Around Kherson and Mykolaiv as of August 20, 2022, 3:00 PM ET


Assessed Control of Terrain Around Kherson and Mykolaiv as of August 19, 2022, 3:00 PM ET


